A capsule endoscopy is performed to provide an enhanced view of the upper digestive tract which may not be visible with a traditional endoscopy.

Spiral endoscopy is the new per-oral endoscopic procedure for visualizing the small bowel.²⁶ Recently, a per-anal procedure has become available for clinical application. In this procedure, an overtube with a raised helix tip is used to pleat the small bowel.

Small Bowel Endoscopy in Inflammatory Bowel Disease

In patients with suspected Crohn's disease and negative ileocolonoscopy findings, ESGE recommends small-bowel capsule endoscopy as the initial diagnostic modality for investigating the small bowel, in the absence of obstructive symptoms or known stenosis (strong recommendation, moderate quality evidence). ESGE does not recommend routine small-bowel imaging or the use of the PillCam patency capsule prior to capsule endoscopy in these patients (strong recommendation, low quality evidence).
