Click Restore. This will erase everything on your iPod and restore it to factory conditions. Accept the warning prompts and your restore will begin. Mac users will be asked for the administrator password. If using Windows, you may see one or more restore options prompting iTunes to automatically download the latest iPod Software.

Press and hold the buttons for at least 8 seconds. When the Apple logo appears on the screen, the iPod has been reset. You may have to repeat the hard reset process in order for it to work. The easiest way to perform this reset is to set the iPod on a flat surface and use two hands to press the buttons.

On a Mac with macOS Mojave 10.14 or earlier (or on a PC), open iTunes . Connect your iPod touch to your computer and unlock it, entering your passcode if prompted. Select the small icon representing your device in the upper left corner of iTunes. Select Restore iPod touch . Select Restore again to confirm.

How to Restore Your iPod Touch to Factory Settings

You put the iPod into DFU mode. You send the first stage of the restore firmware (called "WTF") to the iPod using mks5lboot. The iPod reconnects with a different USB IDs. You send the second stage of the restore firmware (called "FIRMWARE") to the iPod using mks5lboot. The iPod shows a monochrome disk mode screen.

A soft reset does not affect any of your files and settings. Press and hold the Sleep/Wake button at the top of the device until the power slider appears. Slide the power off slider on the screen to the right to power off. Once off, press the Sleep/Wake button again until the device starts.

How To Factory Reset the iPod Touch - Tech Junkie

Hit the "Device" icon on top of the window, head to "Summary" tab and press the "Restore iPod" button. Step 3. On the warning box, click "Restore" again to trigger the iPod resetting process immediately. On iPod Nano 6th and 7th, force restart the iPod, and then press both the "Volume Up" and "Volume Down" buttons until iPod enters DFU mode.

4 Ways to (Factory) Reset iPod nano/shuffle/classic/touch

Click Restore [device]. If you're signed in to Find My, you need to sign out before you can click Restore. Click Restore again to confirm. Your computer erases your device and installs the latest iOS, iPadOS or iPod software. After your device restores to factory settings, it restarts. Now you can set it up as new.

Press and hold both the Sleep/Wake and Home button until the screen turns off. Then wait a few seconds for your device to restart. Still need help? Plug your iPod into power, then try again.

Select your device by clicking the "device" icon. In the Summary panel hold the Option key and click Update or Restore if using a Mac, or hold the Shift key and click Update or Restore if using a Windows PC. Step 3: Now select your IPSW file. Browse for the download location, select the file, and click Choose.

Click the iPod button. The Summary sync page appears, displaying sync options. Select the Manually Manage Music and Videos check box (on an iPod shuffle, select Manually Manage Music; if the iPod touch is synced to iTunes Match, select Manually Manage Videos).

How to Manage Your iPod Library Manually - dummies

Press the "Sleep/Wake" button on top of the iPod Touch, and simultaneously press the bezel button at the bottom of the screen. Hold down the buttons for 10 seconds until the screen goes black. Release the buttons once the Apple logo appears on the screen.

How to reset your iPod Touch without a computer

To reset an iPod nano, press the sleep/wake button and the Home button for six seconds, until the Apple logo appears. To reset the iPod classic, follow these steps: Toggle the hold switch. Slide the hold switch to the right, exposing the orange layer, to lock the buttons, and then slide it back to unlock.

On 1st-6th Gen. iPod touch: Press and hold the Home button (located on the front of the iPod touch) and the sleep/wake button (located on the top)
