### Education Guidance for Refugee and Asylum Seekers

Education for refugee and asylum seeking children. In 2017, Unicef UK commissioned research to understand how far refugee and asylum-seeking children are currently accessing their right to education in the UK. For children on the move who come to the UK, education is one of the first and most critical services they need access to.

### Access to education for refugee and asylum seeking ...

Education is compulsory for children from 5 to 16. This includes children seeking asylum, who attend mainstream schools local to where they live under the same conditions, formally, as other children in their area. However, destitution may affect their access to education.

An asylum-seeker is someone whose request for sanctuary has yet to be processed. Every year, around one million people seek asylum. National asylum systems are in place to determine who qualifies for international protection. However, during mass movements of refugees, usually as a result of ...

### UNHCR - Asylum-Seekers

A defensive application for asylum occurs when you request asylum as a defense against removal from the U.S. For asylum processing to be defensive, you must be in removal proceedings in immigration court with the Executive Office for Immigration Review (EOIR). Individuals are generally placed into defensive asylum processing in one of two ways:-

Local authorities (LAs) have a duty to provide full-time education for all children of compulsory school age resident in that LA, as outlined in Section 14 of the Education Act 1996. Refugee and asylum seeker children aged 5-16 have the same entitlement to full-time education as other children in the UK.

### Refugee and asylum seeker children in UK schools - NALDIC

While in immigration detention, asylum seekers and refugees have a variety of needs, which may include torture and trauma counseling, access to family tracing services, access to legal and migration advice, interpreting and translation, health and mental health care, and access to education and recreational activities.

Young refugees and asylum seekers in Hong Kong experience considerable delays in accessing mainstream schools, with their education depending on the availability of places and chances.

### No Future for the Children of Asylum Seekers in Hong Kong ...

Similarly, asylum seekers face difficulties in education and training what is mostly caused by limited knowledge of the British education system, poor level of English and high costs (NIACE, 2009). Finally, asylum seekers are the victims of crime rather than offenders.

### Asylum seekers and refugees as a social problem in the UK ...

Asylum-seekers have access to healthcare, and are insured for most medical expenses as well as against consequences of legal liability. Children are entitled to education. Asylum-seekers are allowed to work for 24 weeks per year. Asylum-seekers are entitled to legal assistance by a lawyer during the asylum procedure. Asylum-seekers do not have to pay for their lawyer. Once an asylum-seeker has been granted refugee status and a residence permit, the asylum-seeker will be offered housing ...
